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SPORTS POLICY

PREAMBLE:

I.G.N. College has developed and adopted a Sports Policy which aims at developing the overall personality of the students through Sports and Physical activities. Students are motivated to participate in Intramurals and Extra-Mural tournaments which are organized by the college and universities. As Physical Education is an integral part of the holistic development of a person, the management, Principal and each and every faculty member of the institution gives special consideration to promote participation of students in various sports and health related activities.

FACILITIES:

The College has well maintained playfields, Multi- purpose Hall for indoor games, Basketball court, Volleyball court and concrete cricket pitch within the campus. These facilities are provided to the players of various games and sports such as Badminton, Chess, Table tennis, Taekwondo, Wushu, Football, Karate, Kabaddi (NS), Athletics, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Weight lifting/power lifting, Wrestling, kayaking/Yachting/ canoeing, Cricket, Cycling, Taekwondo and shooting.

The college provides the following infrastructure for sports and games:

- 400 Mtrs. Grassy Track for Athletics
- Football Ground
- Basketball Court with Flood Lights
- Volleyball Court
- Kabaddi Court
- Table Tennis Court
- Kho Kho
- Badminton Court
- Cricket Ground with Clay Pitch
- Concrete Cricket Pitch for Practice

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE POLICY

The objective of the scheme is to facilitate college regular students and the medal winner sports persons who are studying in Colleges in full time regular courses including other professional/self finance courses by providing them financial assistance and helping them to achieve higher levels of performance.

GOVERNANCE

A Sports Committee of College is hereby constituted for the implementation of the policy and the overall achievement of sports activities.

The composition of the Committee is as follows:

1. Principal of the College.
2. Convener of the Committee.
3. Member of the Committee (Teaching staff members from all streams as per requirements)
4. Head of Physical Education and minimum one member from each stream is mandatory.
5. A student representative (must be a sports person).

The Committee meeting is to be headed by principal. It should hold the meeting four times a year - once at the start and the end of each Semester/Term. It could also meet at any other time as per requirement.

The chief objective of the Sports Committee is to promote the sports activities in the institution.

The College Sports Committee will approve the Sports Policy and all the financial aspects.

PATTERN OF ASSISTANCE

- (i) The pattern of assistance will be depending upon the level of performance of the concerned sports person.
- (ii) The financial assistance depending upon the eligibility of the students concerned. The student will be responsible for submitting all relevant documents as per the guidelines and the Proforma of the scheme.
- (iii) Keeping in view the lesser attendance in classes of the concerned sports persons because of their engagement in sporting activity, the college will make special efforts in terms of completion of attendance and syllabus.

Eligibility for Scholarship

At the time of admission against sports seats, the players should have a minimum standing in recognized sports in any of the following categories:

1. First, Second and Third position at the State level Tournament.
2. First, Second and Third position in the Inter-College Level Tournament.
3. The admission in sports quota should be on the recommendations of the coach after the trials conducted by Department of Physical education.

Detail of Fee Structure for Sport Students:

- (a) Sportsperson who gets position in recognized sports tournaments at **State /Inter-Collegiate level, participated at National/Inter-University Level and position at national/All India University level** in the sports which are included in university sports calendar (Preference given to individual games) will pay only University dues at the time of admission in UG/PG courses. He/She will not pay the rest of the college dues.
- (b) Outstanding sports person who got a position in recognized sports tournaments at International level competitions included in Kurukshetra university sports calendar will be provided complete free education facilities at the time of admission.
4. The fee concessions and other facilities will be withdrawn in case a player is punished for indiscipline in the College/University.

Sports Students: Training

- If required the coaches will be arranged to train the players.
- The attendance of students is mandatory for all the players in both morning and evening training sessions at their respective center/ playground as per the requirement of the game.

- Members of various teams must report punctually at their respective training centers for daily practice and for matches; otherwise, facilities / incentives given to them will be withdrawn.

Sports Prizes:

The College awards various prizes to motivate the students and excel their performance in sports. **The detail of prizes is as follows:**

- **All Round Best Player of the College:** The College honours the best player of the current session with a trophy and **Rs. 1000/-** cash as incentive.
- **COLLEGE COLOUR:** The College honours the winners of I, II and III positions in all India Inter-University competitions and participants of International competitions with College Colour (College Badge and Certificate).
- **CERTIFICATE OF MERIT:** The College gives cash incentive of Rs. 650/- to the participants of North Zone and All India Interschool Championships.

INCENTIVES:

The cash incentives and benefits for Sport students are as follows:

- (i) The students who win medals at Kurukshetra University Inter-Collegiate/ State Inter-Collegiate and state -level events (Kurukshetra University sports calendar events) in recognized tournaments, the gold, silver and bronze medal winners will receive the following cash incentives on the occasion of Annual Athletic Meet Prize distribution ceremony.

Gold Medal in Inter-Collegiate Tournament = Rs. 350/-

Silver Medal in Inter-Collegiate Tournament = Rs. 300/-

Bronze Medal in Inter-Collegiate Tournament = Rs. 250/-

- (ii) The participants of All-India University/North Zone All India University /National level events (Kurukshetra university sports calendar events) of recognized tournaments will get Rs. 650/- cash incentive.

- (iii) The students who win medals at National and All India University level events (Kurukshetra university sports calendar events) of recognized tournaments, the gold, silver and bronze medal winner will receive the following cash incentive on the occasion of Annual Athletic Meet Prize Distribution ceremony.

Gold Medal in National and All India University Tournament = Rs. 800/-

Silver Medal in National and All India University Tournament = Rs. 750/-

Bronze Medal in National and All India University Tournament = Rs. 700/-

- (iv) The participants of International Level events (Kurukshetra university sports calendar events) in recognized tournaments will get the Rs.1000/- cash incentive on the occasion of the annual Athletic Meet Prize Distribution ceremony.

Special Facilities for Outstanding Players

Following special facilities are given to the outstanding players:

- Medical-aid in case of injury during competitions upto Rs. 500/-
- Free sports-kit and sports equipment of the concerned sports for participation in Inter-Collegiate Competitions.
- Special scholarship to inspire college students at the time of admission.
- Players are also eligible to apply for Scholarships awarded by Kurukshetra University, NIS –Patiala and Haryana Administration sports department and other scholarships.
- Special refreshments are given to players during participation and preparation of Inter-College competitions, Annual Sports Meet and other sport celebrations.

Refreshment of Players during Inter-Collegiate Competitions:

Tournament Daily Allowance (DA)

- DA of player's Rs 100 per Day/-

Refreshment

Refreshment of one player for team game is Rs. 15 per match

Refreshment of player for individual event is Rs. 25 per match

Traveling Allowance

T.A. of players Actual Roadways bus fare and local traveling allowances

In case of the pre- arrangement of the Coaching Camp before the Kurukshetra University Inter-College Championship for certain games, the players will be provided a diet at the rate of Rs. 100/- per day.

Remuneration for Coaches/team Manager

The Remuneration for Coaches/team manager of various Games and Sports will be as per the Haryana Government T.A/D.A. rules and regulation.

Social welfare:

The college gives special consideration to the welfare of the health standard of the surrounding society. Keeping in view this special concern, the college has allowed the people of the surrounding area to use the facility of the college ground before and after the college working hours without disturbing the sport practices of regular students and abiding by the rules of the college. The facility is provided to the community without charging any fee.

FINANCE

Development and upgradation of sport infrastructure; purchase and upkeep of equipment and giving requisite incentives to the students involves considerable expenditure. According to

KUSC, Letter no. Sports/21/659, dated 17-08-2021, the college is annually receiving Rs.220/- from each regular student in which Rs. 135/- is KUSC registration fee and Rs. 85/- is college fee for sports fund. The college also tries to tap CSR funding of corporate, financial help for individual sponsors, approach alumni, parents, well-wishers, etc.

PROCEDURE FOR MONITORING

- (i) The students will submit his/her progress report regarding the sports performance in prescribed format to avail the benefits of various schemes.
- (ii) The Colleges will maintain the records of all the outstanding sportspersons and their incentives & grants.
- (iii) The student availing the above mentioned scheme will not be able to avail the benefits in case he/she has been debarred.
- (iv) Any student who discontinues the playing or denies playing for college after availing sports benefits at the time of admission will have to refund the amount disbursed to him/her.

CANCELLATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

College may terminate scholarship of student in the following cases:

- (a) Misconduct of the awardees, if any, reported by the University/College.
- (b) Unsatisfactory progress report i.e. if the candidate frequently fails to follow university/college rules and regulation.
- (c) The cash incentive/scholarship/admission benefits may be terminated by the college, on the recommendation of the principal at any time during the tenure and the decision of the Sports committee will be final and binding.
- (d) In the subsequent years these benefits shall depend on their subsequent sports performance (In the current session college will consider the achievements of the last two academic sessions for scholarship because no tournaments were conducted in the last academic session due to COVID-19).
- (e) The player will be bound to participate in Kurukshetra University Inter-Collegiate and All India University tournaments in relevant games otherwise college has the power to withdraw all facilities given to him/her.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE CANDIDATE IN THE COLLEGE:

1. The candidate is required to submit an application in the prescribed format for availing the benefits.
2. A Certificate of participation / medal winner as per the eligibility mentioned above as proof (Attested by Principal).

CERTIFICATES TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE CONCERNED CANDIDATES:

Every year students will submit a complete statement of the following:

1. Statement giving the complete details of the students selected for the scholarship along with their receipt of scholarship amount.
2. Progress Report to be submitted after the completion of first year in terms of sports performance and academics.
3. Utilization certificate for the previous grant released.

4. A certificate giving justification for continuance of the scholarship issued by the Director/Head of the Department duly forwarded by the Registrar/Principal.
