ACHARYA PRAFULLA CHANDRA RAY
(27 August 1867 – 18 June 1946)

Acharya Dr. Prafulla Chandra Ray (1867-1946) served as the first Director of Indian Institute of Chemical Technology (IICT) in 1950. He was a pioneer in the field of chemical education in India. He was also a member of the Council of Ministers, Government of India.

SHANTI SWAROOP BHATNAGAR
(21 February 1894 – 01 January 1955)



Shanti Swaroop Bhatnagar revered as the father of research laboratories in India, was an Indian colloid chemist, academic and scientific administrator. Shanti Swaroop Bhatnagar played a significant part in the building of India's post-independence science and technology infrastructure and policies. He was the first Director General of the CSIR and led India's journey towards self-reliance.

His love for making India self-reliant was so much, that he left his lucrative offers abroad and returned to India in August 1921 after completing his PhD. Upon his return, he immediately joined the newly established Banarus Hindu University (BHU) as a Professor of Chemistry, where he remained for three years.

Shanti Swaroop Bhatnagar wrote the 'Kulgeet' (University Anthem) for BHU.

Dr. Bhatnagar provided innovative solutions to several industrial problems and persistently refused personal monetary benefit in research facilities at universities. Bhatnagar was responsible for the initiation of the Industrial Research Association movement in the country.

He constituted the one-man Commission in 1935 to regulate the oil companies for starting refineries and his ultimately led to the establishment of many oil refineries in different parts of the country.

He induced many individuals and organisations to donate liberally for the cause of science and education in India.

Acharya Prafulla Chandra Ray, an illustrious pioneer in the field of plant physiology, was an eminent biochemist, educationist, scientist, environmentalist and patriot.

His research work in the field of plant physiology, particularly his discovery of the hormone 'Auxin', has been a landmark in the history of plant physiology. He was also the first Indian to participate in the world's first space mission on 'Aryabhata' in 1975.

Acharya P.C. has received numerous awards and honours, including the Bharat Ratna, Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan, Padma Shri, and the J.C. Bose Award.


