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Student Feedback Summary for Commerce Students (Session 2023-24)

A feedback survey was conducted among students of the Commerce Department following the completion of the academic session. The survey was distributed via Google Form, with 47 students participating. The form comprised 16 questions related to the curriculum and the overall college ambience.

Key findings from the feedback include:

1. **Curriculum Suitability:** A significant 87.4% of students expressed satisfaction with the suitability of the course curriculum.
2. **Clarity of Aims and Objectives:** 85.1% of students strongly agreed or agreed that the aims and objectives of the curriculum were clearly defined and communicated.
3. **Career Orientation and Expert Lectures:** A majority of students acknowledged that the department organized various expert lectures to guide their career orientation.
4. **Theory and Application Balance:** Students generally felt that the curriculum maintained a good balance between theoretical knowledge and practical application.
5. **Personality Development:** Most students agreed that the curriculum contributed to their overall personality development.
6. **Practical Relevance:** 72.3% of students found the curriculum relevant in addressing and resolving daily life problems.
7. **Timely Completion of Curriculum:** 78.7% of students were satisfied with the timely completion of the curriculum within the prescribed teaching days.
8. **Internal Assessment System:** 46.8% of students agreed that the internal assessment system, as prescribed by the university, was fair and unbiased.
9. **Extracurricular Activities:** 85.1% of students confirmed that extracurricular activities were regularly organized within the college.
10. **College Facilities Satisfaction:** Satisfaction with the college facilities was high, with the following percentages of students expressing satisfaction:
